

Debate Competition: “Will Artificial Intelligence Ultimately Replace Human Jobs?” (16 October 2024)

The Commerce Department Society *Devoir* of Bhagini Nivedita College organized a Debate Competition on 16 October 2024 on the thought-provoking topic, “Will Artificial Intelligence Ultimately Replace Human Jobs?” under the guidance of Dr. Rachna Mahalwala. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation, with 41 students presenting diverse perspectives on the opportunities and challenges posed by the increasing use of AI in the workplace.

Participants discussed how AI can enhance efficiency, reduce costs, and automate repetitive tasks, while also raising concerns about job displacement in sectors such as manufacturing, customer service, and logistics. The debate highlighted the need for continuous reskilling and adaptability to meet the demands of an evolving job market. The discussion concluded that the future is likely to involve collaboration between humans and AI rather than complete replacement.

Five prizes, including two consolation awards, were presented to outstanding participants. The event provided a valuable platform for students to develop critical thinking, communication, and analytical skills while engaging with a contemporary issue of global significance.
