The *Saree Draping Competition* was organized on Thursday, 12th September 2024 in collaboration with the Home Science Department Society. The competition comprised three creative rounds – Traditional Style, Bollywood-Inspired, and Creative Fusion – each reflecting different aspects of draping, styling, and interpretation.
