

Educational Visit to a Garment Export House

An educational visit to Neetee Apparels, Udyog Vihar, Gurugram was organized for the students of BA Programme Semester 5 - Apparel Design and Construction (ADC), Bhagini Nivedita College. The visit was organized to provide students with practical exposure to the garment manufacturing process, complementing their courses on Garment Manufacturing and Apparel Quality Management. The students were accompanied by the faculty members Dr. Rachna Mohan and Ms. Divya Sharma. Upon arrival at Neetee Apparels, the students were welcomed by the management team, who gave an overview of the company's operations and its role in the garment industry.

During the visit, students observed various departments and a detailed overview of essential garment manufacturing processes such as Fabric Checking, Spreading, Cutting, Washing, Sewing, Finishing, and Packing. They observed the use of specialized sewing machines and the finishing and packing employed in mass production. The visit was a valuable experience for the students, providing them with a deeper understanding of the garment manufacturing process and insight into the functioning of a large-scale apparel production unit. The exposure to both the theoretical and practical aspects of the industry will aid the students in their ongoing studies and future career planning.
